Context:

- Jesus said that wars and rumors of wars is a sign of the Last Days
- Humankind is controlled by animosity and conflict resulting in violence of war
- The wars of humanity are taking exponential leaps into world wars with ever greater casualties
- Prophecy foretells that humanity will make even greater war in the future
- The horseman on the red horse of the four horseman of the Apocalypse in Revelation 6 foretells a time of great war when there is no peace on earth
- There is a serious escalation of world war in the future when nations cast aside restraint
- The prophecies in Revelation 9 describe future world war that kills a third of mankind
- The Revelation 9 world war starts in the Middle East at the Euphrates River when four fallen angels or demons that were bound are released there
- The Euphrates River runs through the Middle Eastern Islamic countries of Turkey, Syria, Iraq, and Iran
- The demonic turmoil released into the world from the Euphrates River area Islamic countries creates instability in the world through conflict, terror, and atrocities
- This draws the nations of the world to the Middle East in escalating warfare until their armies fill the air like swarms of metal locusts with power to kill.

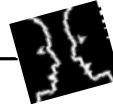
